Submission to the Review Committee.



## **GATS**

**THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT.**

GATS HAS RECEIVED NO COVERAGE IN THE POPULAR MEDIA, NO PARLIAMENTARY OR OPEN PUBLIC DEBATE OF ANY KIND. NOBODY SEEMS TO KNOW ABOUT IT, BUT BEING A PARTY TO GATS, AS AUSTRALIA IS, WILL RESULT IN MASSIVE CHANGES TO OUR LIVES IN AUSTRALIA.

**GATS is an INTERNATIONAL, WORLD TRADE ORGANISATION (WTO) General Agreement on Trade in Services -- all services, including police, water supply, armed services, telephone, construction, education, transport, environmental, etc.**

GATS identifies 160 services, which includes just about every service except prostitution.

GATS is about putting all government supplied services out to international tender.

The lowest tender must be accepted, regardless of which country it comes from.

The winning tender will be unrestricted and able to bring into Australia its own workers at whatever rates of pay the successful tender wishes to pay, to supply the service.

GATS becomes final in November 2002 and we will have had no say in the agreement because we have not been advised about it.

We will be placed in the hands of international cartels supplying services through cheap labour countries.

This means that a USA, British, French, German, Russian or North Korean cartel operating from India or Indonesia or some other country could be running our social security service and any number of other services including the Police service, in fact running Australia, because they were the lowest tender.

The only jobs that will be available will be at rates of pay equal to those in the country from where the tender came. So a bowl of rice a day is now in the offering.

The end result is the international cartels – Money Power – will be making huge profits and the world's people will be their slaves.

In preparation for this massive change, our governments of both political persuasions have been paving the way for international cartels by allowing them to gain control of our major service industries, banks, communications, distribution, water supply, electricity.

Government will say, "Yes, we have signed the GATS but there is no compulsion. We do not have to do as it says". The question then is, why sign it? It is time to recall the Lima Declaration agreed to in 1976, when we agreed to wind down our industry and send it off shore and to abolish tariffs. This also was said to be not compulsory, but we followed it to the letter.

You have heard about the level playing field. Well get ready for it, it's on our door step.

GATS will come into effect in November 2002 unless we get off our rear-end and stop it. **We have the power to stop it.**
